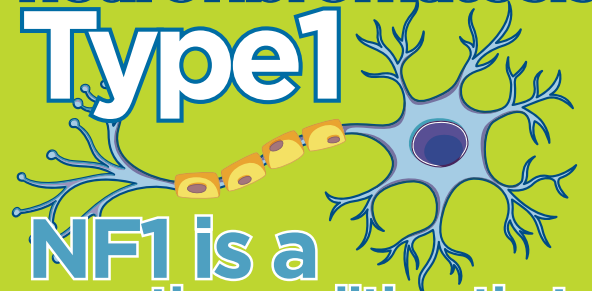


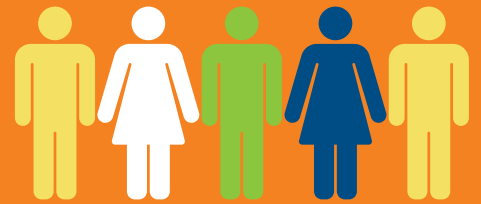
**NF1** occurs in
