

CLINICAL TRIAL SUMMARY DESCRIPTION

TITLE: Diagnosis of Pheochromocytoma

OBJECTIVE OF STUDY: To develop better methods of diagnosis and treatment of pheochromocytomas (tumors which usually arise from the adrenal glands, causing high blood pressure)

MINIMUM ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS: Open to ALL ages, patients with pheochromocytoma will be accepted based on referral from clinicians, adult patients must be able to mentally and physically consent to participation in study

PARTICIPANT ACTIVITIES (*office visits, tests, take medications, etc*): Medical testing and screening, standard imaging tests, DNA analysis, a test to detect pheochromocytoma – if found, patient will be offered surgery, patients must be willing to return to NIH for follow up evaluation
