Head north on Wadsworth Parkway to 94th Avenue and turn left.  
Stay on 94th Avenue to Lark Bunting Drive and turn left.  
Oakhurst Park and pavilion are on your right.

**From 1-25 and 104th Ave:**

Go west on East 104th Avenue.  
East 104th Avenue becomes West 104th Avenue, then West  
104th Avenue becomes Church Ranch Boulevard and then  
becomes 100th Avenue at Wadsworth Parkway.  
Turn left, heading south, turn right at 94th Avenue.  
Stay on 94th Avenue to Lark Bunting Drive and turn left.  
Oakhurst Park and pavilion are on your right.
